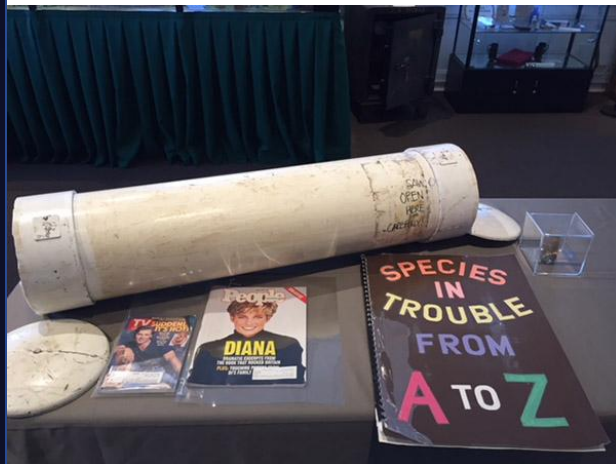




Snowball Fight
