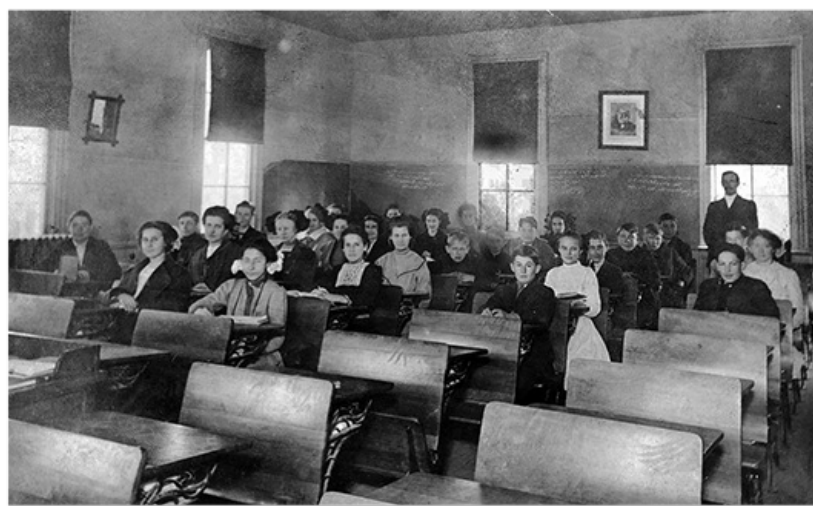


Glen Carbon's Acme School



On Saturday, August 4th, former students and their families gathered at the Acme School Pocket Park for a dedication of the new sign honoring the school and the students who attended. The sign features pictures of the old school building and student classes from 1914, 1937 and 1950. Acme school was in operation from 1910 to 1955 when Glen Carbon schools consolidated with the Edwardsville School District. Considering the time span of nearly 65 years since the school closing, the interest and comradery of the former Acme students was inspiring. Mayor Rob Jackstadt was on hand to welcome the students. Several states were represented with one former student making the trip from her home in Mexico just for this dedication.
